He has been the member for the Thomastown electorate since 1990 and Manager of Government Business in the Legislative Assembly since 1999. Prior to being elected to Parliament, he was the Victorian Secretary of the Australian Labor Party from 1983 - 1990.

As Victorian Minister for Energy and Resources, Peter Batchelor is responsible for delivering the Brumby Government's energy policy, *Meeting Victoria's Energy Challenge*. The policy aims to deliver affordable, reliable energy to Victorian families and businesses in an environmentally and socially responsible way.

Minister Batchelor is also responsible for the portfolio of Community Development which aims to build strong, inclusive and cohesive communities by encouraging local planning, volunteering and social participation, and supporting the role of community organisations across the state.
